### ***Integrated M.Phill-Ph.D Statute***

#### **19 Research Supervisor:**

*A teacher working in the University Department/Centre (recognized as Research Centre) on substantive basis shall be eligible to be the supervisor for guiding M. Phil. /Ph.D. scholars provided he/she has to his/her credit:*

- i) *A Ph.D. Degree;*

- ii) *Publication of at least three research papers of high standard to be determined by the BORS; and*
- i) *Post Ph.D one year teaching/research experience at the P.G. level or one year post doctoral research experience.*
- ii) *In exceptional cases, Vice-Chancellor may relax the experience.*

**Item No. 3** To consider the application submitted by following JRF and NET candidates for registration to Ph.D Programme
