<u>Circular</u>

A meeting of the members of Departmental Committee and the Principal's of the affiliated law colleges was held on 12th October, 2020 regarding the determination of mode and method of examination for BALLB 10th semester and LLB 6th semester. Keeping in view the UGC guidelines on COVID -19, the BCI guidelines regarding the same and the recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Praneeth and Ors. v. University Grants Commission and Ors. [Writ Petition (Civil) No. 724 of 2020 - Judgment Dated 28.08.2020], the Committee unanimously resolved as follows:

 That the end-semester examination for the above-mentioned semesters will be conducted in the 'offline' mode. The date - sheet for the same and detailed guidelines for the implementation of COVID - 19 SOP's will be issued in due course of time.

a. Examination Centers:

There shall be the following examination centers for the smooth conduct of the end semester examination of these two semesters. Further, the students will be given choice to appear in any one of these centers as per their convenience, subject to the prior registration / approval and appearance of all the papers of a particular semester in one Center only.
