NOTICE

This is for the information of all the students of School of Law and Affiliated Law Colleges that the Bar Council of India, elaborated and clarified in its General Council Meeting of 5th October, 2020 [Item No. 541/2020]: its two Circulars dated 27th May, 2020 and 9th June, 2020. The necessary portion from these two circulars, which are expressly mentioned by the BCI in its 5th October, 2020 is reproduced as follows:

"All students, except Final year students, will be promoted on the basis of performance of previous year's marks and marks obtained in the internal examination of the current year. However, it is clarified that after reopening of the colleges/Universities, the Universities shall conduct the end semester examination with respect to the year from which they have been promoted, within a reasonable period of time, though, such promoted students shall continue to study in the year to which they have been promoted, and in case, they are unable to pass/clear any such paper of such end semester exam of the year from which they have been promoted, they shall have to clear the same, before they are granted the degree. In the case of students who have been promoted to the final year as LL.B. students, they shall have to pass all papers in order to obtain their degree/s."

Keeping in view the clarification given by BCI in its General Council Meeting of 5th October, 2020 [Item No. 541/2020] following decision was taken by the Departmental Committee alongwith the Principals/ Representatives of the Affiliated Law Colleges:

"The students presentlyⁱⁿ BALLB 2nd, 4th, 6th, & 7th and LLB 2nd & 3rd are hereby provisionally promoted to the next semesters respectively. However, these students will have to appear in the examination (offline) of the previous semester once the COVID - 19 pandemic is over and the university physically reopens and starts to operate normally. Further, the students of the above mentioned semesters shall have to submit the examination forms within the prescribed time period as already notified and extended from time to time. Moreover, the time - table for the classwork of the new semesters will be issued shortly and the classes for the time being will be conducted online from 23rd October, 2020."
